



Dear Community Partner:

As you may be aware, we are experiencing a good deal of construction on our Valhalla campus and are consolidating our services. To that end, beginning the morning of August 2, please follow appropriate directional signage:

- All medical, pediatric and behavioral health care patients being transported by ambulance, police department or car to our organization for emergent care should be brought to Westchester Medical Center's Main Emergency Department (follow red EMERGENCY signs on our campus).
- Individuals accepted for transfer by the medical adult or pediatric service should enter through the Main Emergency Department (follow red EMERGENCY signs on our campus).
- Individuals being transported from an outside hospital who have been accepted by the psychiatry service for admission and transfer to the Behavioral Health Center should be admitted through the Behavioral Health Center main entrance (follow signs for Behavioral Health Center).
- Individuals with scheduled appointments at the Behavioral Health Center should enter through the Behavioral Health Center main entrance (follow signs for Behavioral Health Center).
